Drop-off & Pick-up:

Enter the school through the main entrance door (by the front office). Please walk your child to their classroom and sign them in and out each day.

Late Pick-up fee:

Your account will be charged \$5 per minute, per child for pick-up after your camp ends or after 5:30 p.m.



What To Bring (Please label all items):

- Complete change of clothes with shoes and socks.
- Sunscreen
- Water clothes and a towel for water days.
- Two snacks, if staying all day.
- Lunch, if staying all day.
- A refillable water bottle.
- Diapers and wipes (if needed) in PK2.
- A fitted crib sheet and blanket for PK2-PK4 for nap time (the school will provide the nap mats).

Food:

Eagle Camp does not provide lunch. You must send a lunch, snacks, and water bottle from home. Bring your lunch, snacks, and refillable water bottle each day. Label everything, please.

What not to bring:

No toys, phones or electronic devices of any kind. Campers will be busy, active and on the move!

Camp Guidelines:

Eagle Camp is designed to meet the needs of families and provide quality summer care opportunities for PK2- 8th grade students. All children are welcome to attend summer programs regardless of school enrollment. The purpose of Eagle Camp is to provide high-quality, developmentally appropriate activities, and childcare.

- 1. Provide unconditional encouragement and acceptance to build self-esteem and self-confidence.
- 2. Provide a variety of opportunities to help children discover and develop their intellectual, physical, social, and spiritual gifts and abilities to the fullest.

- 4. Provide opportunities to develop responsible, self-reliant, and self-motivated life-long learners.
- 5. Support and enhance parental understanding of child development needs and practices.
- 6. Offer real-life activities to develop skills for successful living.
- 7. Provide positive redirection when needed within a respectful, loving environment.



Behavior Expectations:

Cooperation among children, teachers, and parents is very important to the success of Eagle Camp. Thank you for your help reinforcing the following expectations:

- Children are expected to respect each other, teachers, the school building, and campus.
- Children are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that brings honor to their families, themselves, and their school.
- Children are expected to comply with camp rules and directions in a timely and respectful way. If they do not comply with the rules parents will be notified and administration may consider dismissal with each incident.

Accepted Clothing & Rules:

- Modest length shorts and one-piece swimsuits.
- Athletic shoes are recommended every day at camp.
- All clothes and equipment should be marked with your child's name.

Enrollment:

All Saints' Episcopal School admits students without regard to race, creed, and color, national or ethnic origin. All programs are filled on a first come, first-served basis. Children do not have to be an All Saints student to attend Eagle Camp.

Eagle Camp Cancellation & Transfer Policy:
